NAVY WOUNDED WARRIOR (NWW) - SAFE HARBOR brings resources together to provide non-medical care to seriously wounded, ill and injured Sailors and Coast Guardsmen, and to support their families. Using a holistic approach, NWW offers personalized assistance throughout all phases of the service member's recovery, rehabilitation and return to duty or community reintegration.

ELIGIBILITY

NWW enrollment is available to seriously wounded, ill and injured Sailors and Coast Guardsmen, including:

- OIF/OEF/OND casualties
- Shipboard and training accidents
- Liberty accidents
- Serious medical and psychological conditions (e.g., cancer, severe PTSD)

NWW NON-MEDICAL CARE MANAGEMENT

NWW Non-medical Care Managers tailor support to each service member and his or her family's needs.
